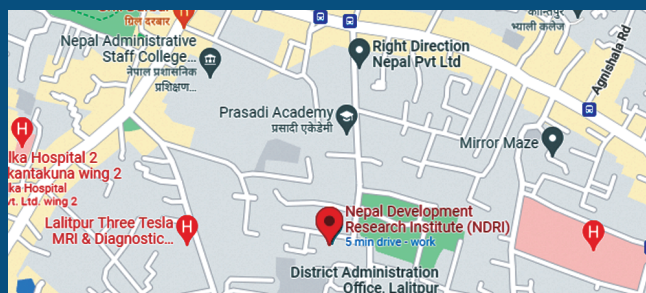

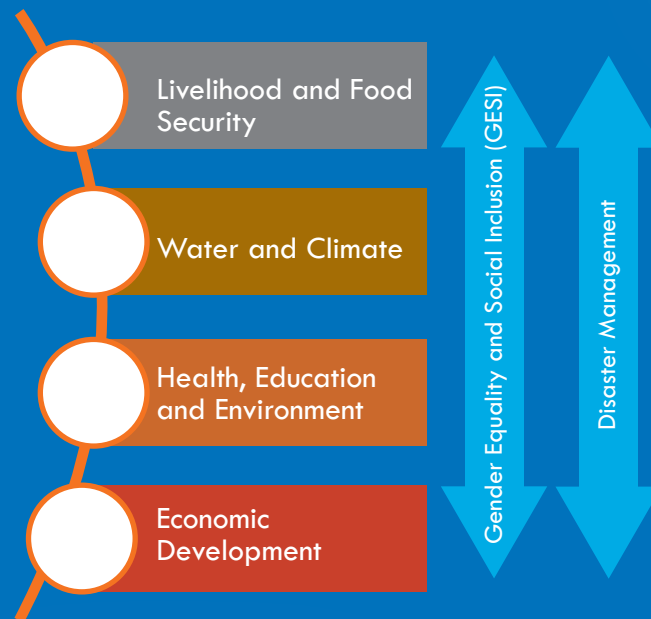
Vision
